Holidays bring out velvet, velveteen

Holiday time brings out red, green and royal blue velvet and velveteen fabrics in special holiday clothes for children. Children are not noted for staying spotless.

What's the difference between velvet and velveteen? They may

seem hard to tell apart, but each fabric has its unique characteristics, says Carol Bennett, County Extension agent.

For example, look at fiber content. Velvet is usually made with filament fibers such as rayon, nylon or silk. Velveteen is made with cotton.

Polyester or nylon velvets, or cotton/blend velveteen fabrics usually are washable, unless the garment has some trim that is not, and usually require no ironing. Rayon velveteen will usually require dry cleaning.

Also, look at warp direction in the fabric, Bennett says. In velvet, the tufts are interlaced with a filling yarn. When the fabric is bent, the pile "breaks" into lengthwise rows.

You may get more good out of a washable velvet or velveteen garment fabric than a dry cleanable one, suggests Bennett. Take the time to shop wisely for those special children's clothes.
