This past year has brought many challenges and rewards for the Soil Conservation Service staff. With the help and cooperation of the farmers in Morrow County we were able to meet the December 31 deadline of preparing conservation plans for every farmer who wanted to stay eligible for USDA programs under the requirements of the 1985 Food Security Act. We wrote 225 plans on 340,000 acres. The Soil Conservation Service also provided continuing technical assistance on streambank erosion to the Port of Morrow, on soil erosion to the Dry Fork Watershed Project and range management on the Navy Bombing Range. In addition, 232,000 feet of terrace were built in Morrow County.
