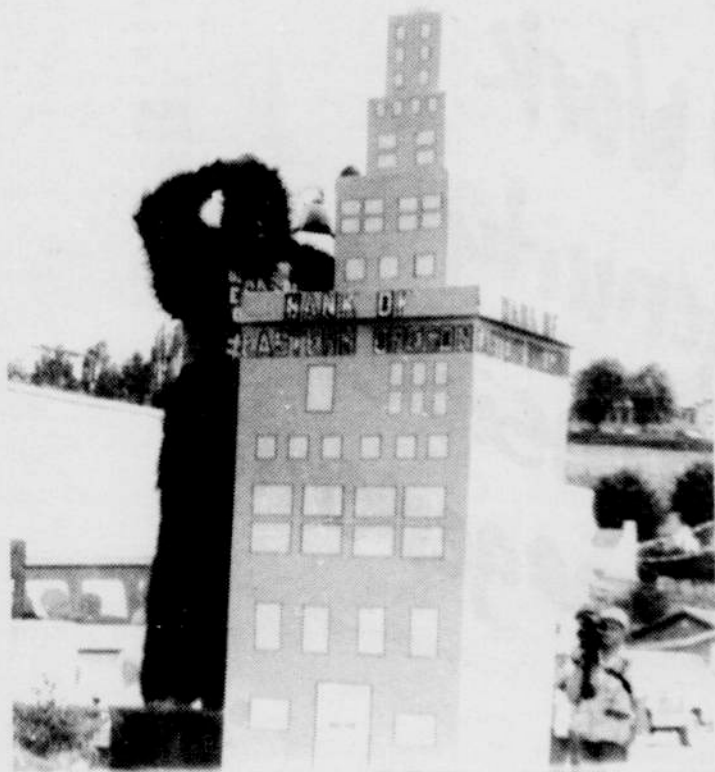


Still time to enter parade

It's time to register for the 1990 Morrow County Fair and Rodeo Parade. The parade this year is to be held August 18 beginning at 10 a.m. Put on your favorite "Blue Jeans and Country Scenes" costume and come join the fun. The sign-in table will be set up on the porch in front of the Green Feed Store and parade entry numbers will be issued starting at 9 a.m.

Fourteen divisions will be judged at this year's parade. Ribbons and prize money will be distributed to the winners. There is over \$450 in prize money available, with the largest single cash award being \$50 in the sweepstakes division. A list of the entries receiving prizes will be posted at the Fair Board office at the Morrow County Fairgrounds, and

checks and ribbons may be picked up and there also.

For all those parade participants under the age of 12, there will be free ice cream at the end of the parade.

Early registration forms are available at Van Marter and Kahl Insurance located at 187 N. Main Street. If you already know what your parade entry will be, please fill out a registration form in advance. If you don't decide to be in the parade until the last minute, registration forms will be at the sign-in table at Green Feed on the day of the parade. Premiums will be \$4 for first, \$3 for second and \$2 for third.
