Padberg to chair UGLY bartender contest

Connie Padberg has offered to chair the 1990 Coors U.G.L.Y. Bartender Contest in Heppner for the Oregon Chapter, National Multiple Sclerosis Society. Padberg will coordinate fund-raising events for the contest in Heppner.

U.G.L.Y. stands for Understanding, Generous, Lovable You.

Ms. Padberg accepted the appointment out of her desire to help fight multiple sclerosis, a chronic disease of the central nervous system that attacks adults between the ages of 20 and 40. Symptoms vary from blurred vision to slurred speech to complete paralysis. There are over 2900 people with MS in the Oregon chapter area alone. The cause is unknown and there is no cure yet.

Ms. Padberg stated that 60 percent of the money raised in the contest will help fund services for Oregonians with MS, and 40 percent will go for research on the disease.

The Ugly Bartender Contest is sponsored by Coors Beer and the National Multiple Sclerosis Society, and will run in Heppner from August 20 to September 16.
