The whole town, including many descendants of Irish pioneers, pitch in to make St. Paddy's Day in Heppner a fun and memorable weekend.

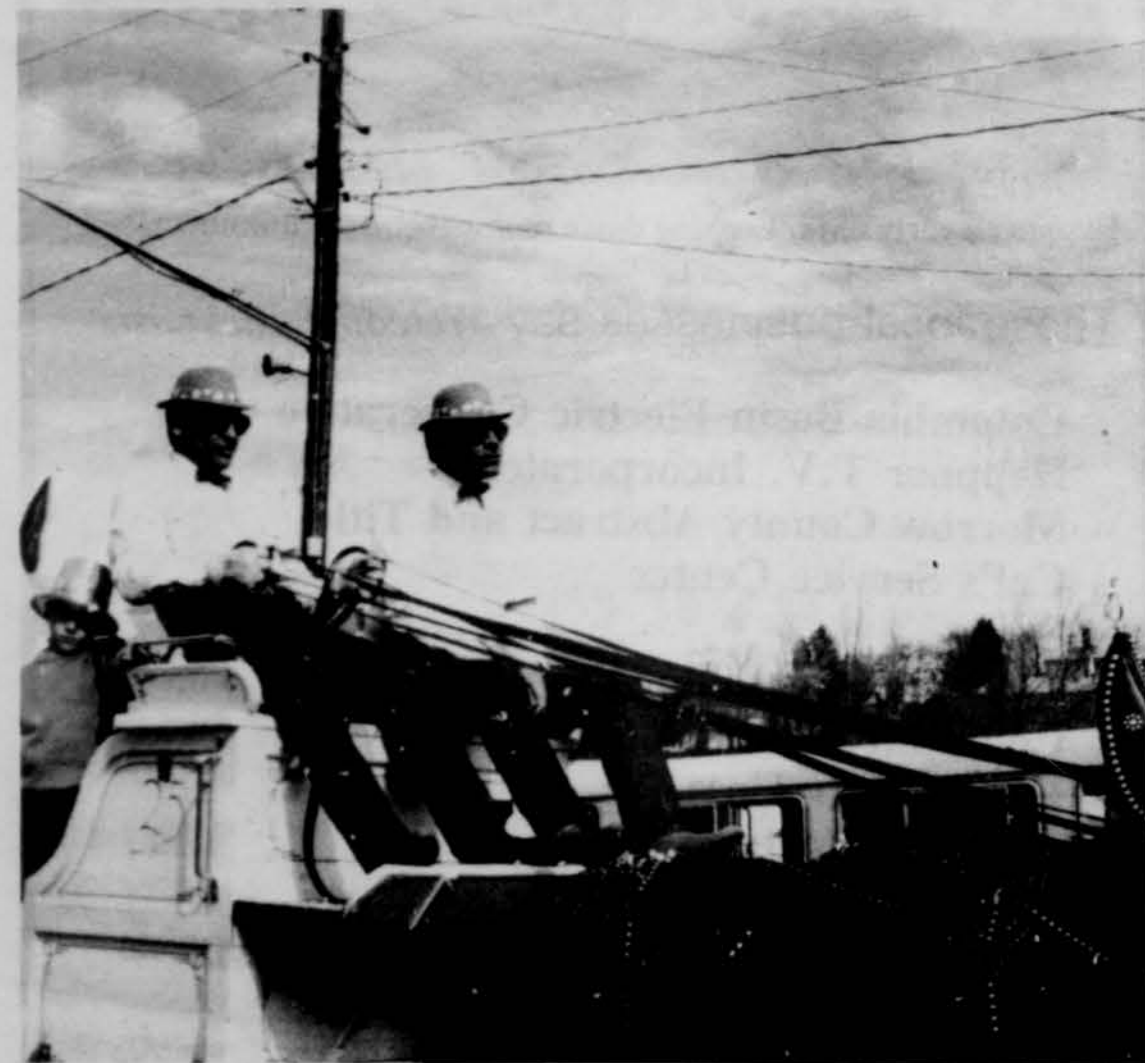

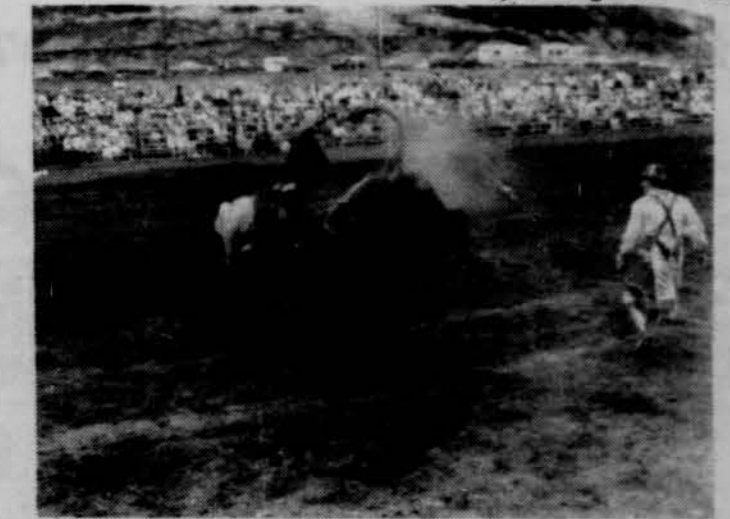
# 100 Things to do in Heppner

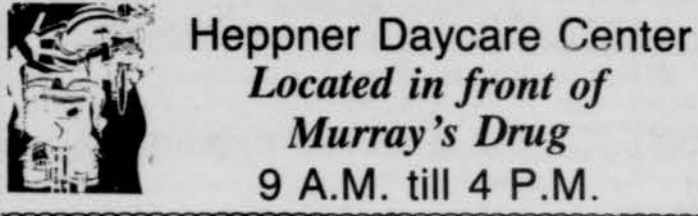
