The territory and boundaries of the proposed district is described as follows: Beginning at the South meander line of the Columbia River and the West Section line of Section 15, Township 5 North, Range 26, E.W.M.; thence South along the West Section line of Sections 15, 22, 27 and 34, Township 5 North, Range 26, E.W.M.; and Sections 3, 10, 15 in Township 4 North, Range 26 E.W.M.; to the right-of-way of the main line of the Union Pacific Railroad Company in a Southeasterly direction 9 miles, more or less, to the East boundary line of Morrow County, Oregon, thence following the boundary line of Morrow County, Oregon North to the South meander line of the Columbia River; thence West to the point of beginning.

The class of livestock which shall not lawfully be permitted to run at large within the proposed livestock district are animals of the bovine species, horses, mules, asses, sheep, goats and swine.
