MEASURE NO. 25-3

TAX BASE FOR OPERATING WILLOW CREEK PARK DISTRICT

QUESTION: SHALL A TAX BASE FOR WILLOW CREEK PARK DISTRICT BE ESTABLISHED IN THE AMOUNT OF \$41,752.00?

SUMMARY: The purpose of this measure is to establish a realistic tax base for the Willow Creek Park District for operations of the facilities, which includes an overnight campsite and RV Park, a dock system, and a Day Park.

This proposed tax base measure does not levy a tax, instead it establishes a new tax base. If this measure is approved the District would be subject to the 6% constitutional limitation and could not exceed this limit without voter approval.

MEASURE NO. 25-2

FORMATION OF IRRIGON LIVESTOCK DISTRICT

QUESTION: SHALL A LIVESTOCK DISTRICT BE FORMED IN THE IRRIGON AREA TO PROHIBIT CERTAIN CLASSES OF LIVESTOCK FROM RUNNING AT LARGE?

SUMMARY: This measure would establish a livestock district in the Irrigon area. Any person who owns, possesses or controls animals of the bovine species, horses, mules, asses, sheep, goats or swine would not be permitted to allow these animals to run at large within the boundaries of the livestock district.
