The Seven Super Sewers 4-H group will be starting their third year of sewing with leader Monica Swanson.

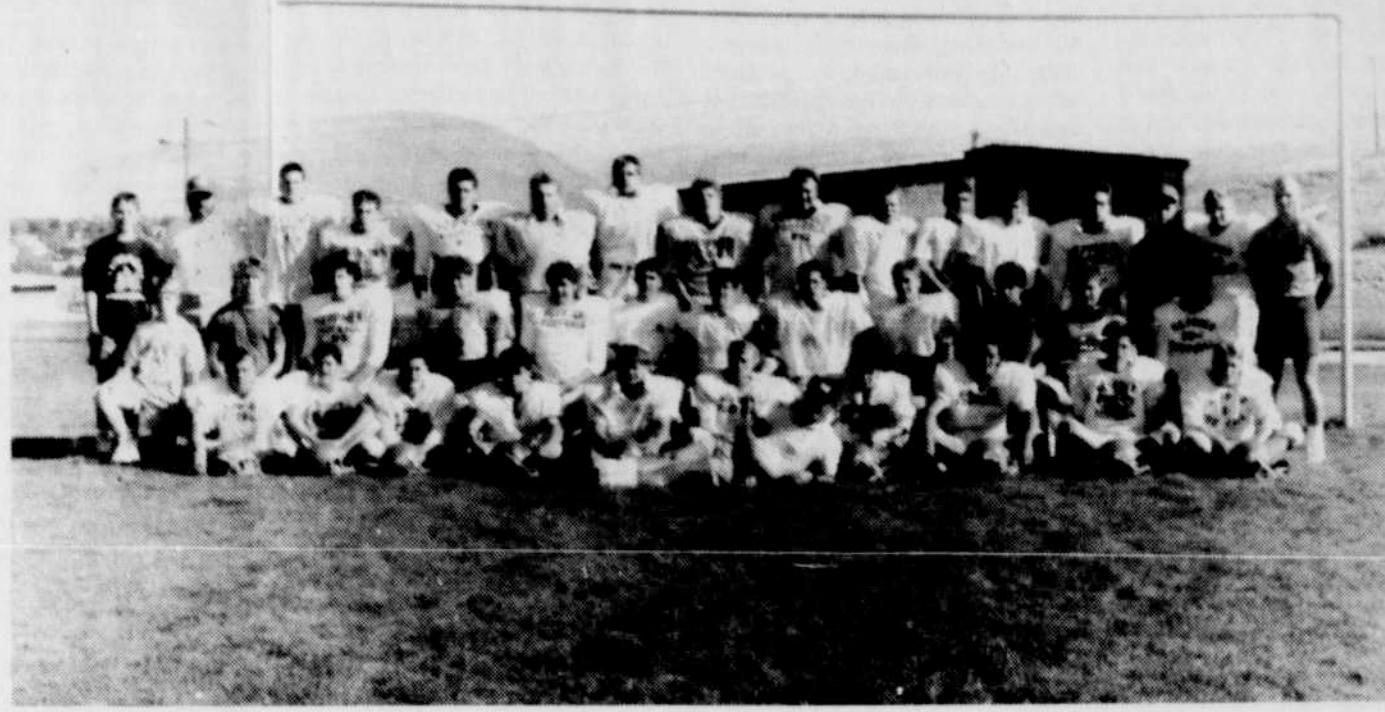
Some of the boys are making a wool garment to enter the Make It With Wool Contest. This will be their first project of the year.
