Don't forget Easter services at local churches along with Easter sunrise services, breakfasts, programs and regular services.

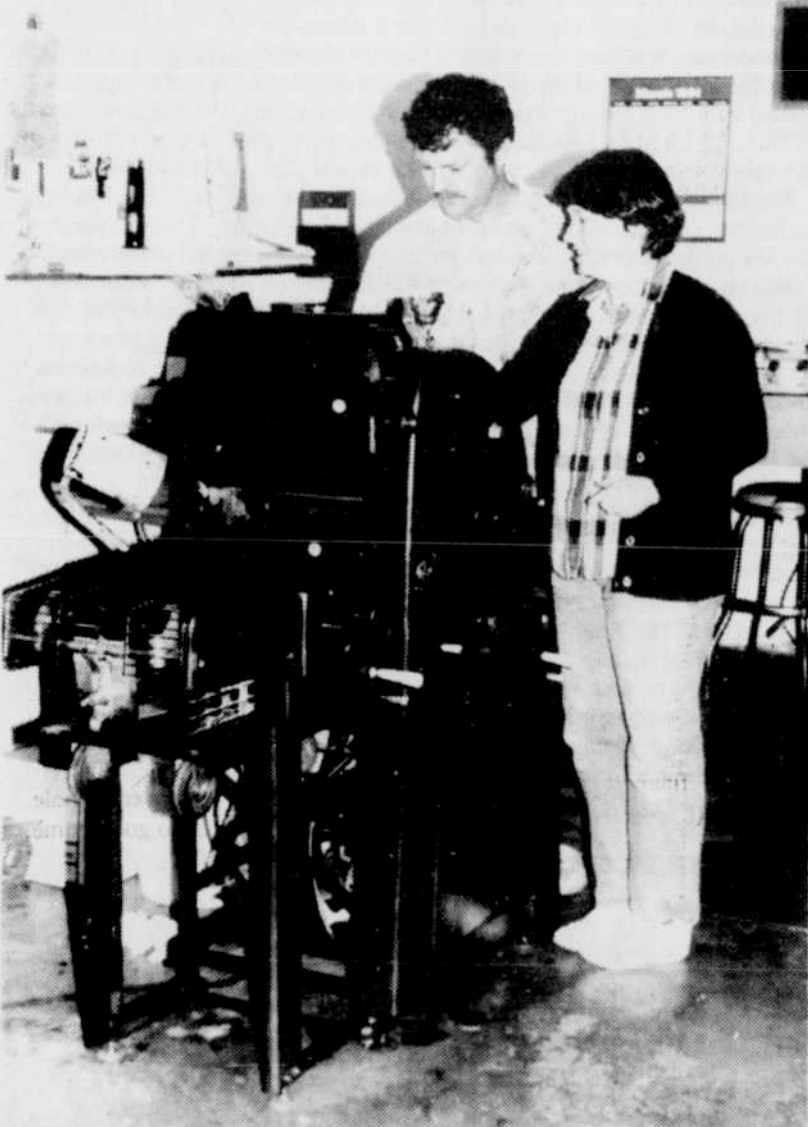
Stroeber earns 4.0 at COCC

NOTICE OF MEASURE ELECTION

Morrow County School District

Notice is hereby given that on Tuesday, May 21, 1991, an election will be held in Morrow County School District, Morrow County, Oregon. The polls will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. The following shall be the ballot title for the measure submitted to the electors thereof:

CAPTION (10 Words): To Establish an Up-To-Date Tax Base
QUESTION (20 Words): Shall Morrow County School District's tax base be increased in 1991-92 to \$9,086,618 from the current base of \$1,053,928?

EXPLANATION (150 Words): The District's present tax base is a hold-over from many years ago. For the past several years, the tax base has provided less than 10% of the money required to operate schools for one year. The purpose of this measure is to establish a \$9,086,618 tax base. This amount will result in a tax rate in 1991-92 below the \$15 per thousand limit required by Ballot Measure #5. This amount matches the district's need for funds to balance the budget and operate one year, 1991-92. Also, this amount is 5.1% increase above this year's safety net amount. The budget committee approved the \$9,086,618 as the levy and tax base amount for 1991-92. If this measure is approved, the school district will be subject to the 6% Constitutional limitation and cannot exceed this limit unless the voters approve a specific amount above the limit.

NOTICE OF SERVICE OF PERSONAL PROPERTY TAX WARRANTS

NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to ORS 311.615 of the service of Personal Property Tax warrants upon the following listed tax payers. Payment of the following listed delinquent taxes with interest and cost of service must be made by April 10, 1991 or said warrants shall be filed with the County Clerk of Morrow County, Oregon, for entry in the County Clerk Lien Record, and shall become a lien upon the title to any interest in real property owned by the person against whom the warrant is issued, and the taxes on personal property embraced in the warrant with interest, penalties and costs applicable thereto, shall continue as a lien on all the personal property of the person assessed as otherwise provided by law. The effect shall be the same as though the people of the county had recovered the judgement against the person charged for the full amount of the delinquent tax covered by the warrant together with interest thereon and cost as provided by law.

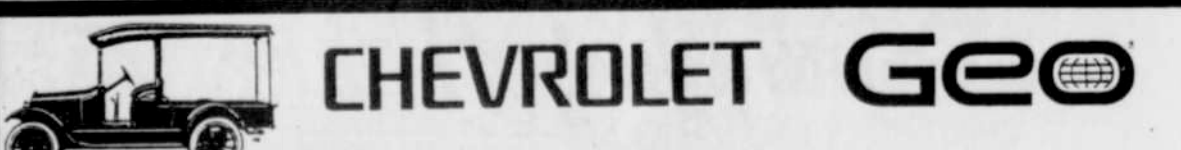
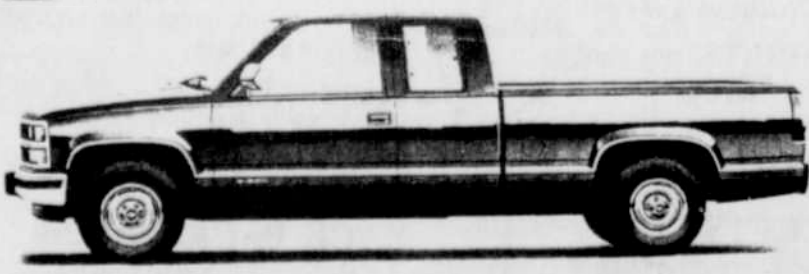
