Cash prizes will be awarded in the Morrow County class for up to sixth place. In open class there is no cubic limit and the contest pays a \$100 jackpot plus entry fees and 100 gallons of gas donated by Devin Oil Company.

Each participant will pay a fee of \$10 per class. Contestants may use only stock saws and no modified chainsaws are allowed in the Morrow County event saws are limited to 5.7 cubic inches and under. The contest is a timed event and two timers will be provided by the fair. The contest

is for amateurs only.
