Parking on Coalmine hill

The Heppner Ranger District announces completion of a paved parking area at the top of Coalmine Hill. This project was developed in conjunction with Morrow County. The Forest Service provided the site, gravel for surfacing, ensured compliance with the National Environmental Policy Act and all "finish work" after construction, such as facilities planning and development. The county was responsible for clearing and grub-

bing the area, disposing of stumps, grading and draining, loading, hauling, placing gravel and paving. The Forest Service has said it will reimburse Morrow County for the surfacing and paving costs.

The site will be used as a trailhead for the Bald Mountain Trail, as an information center, and as a day use/picnic area. Because of the fresh surface and time needed for it to cure, the parking area will not be open for use until mid October, said the Forest Service.

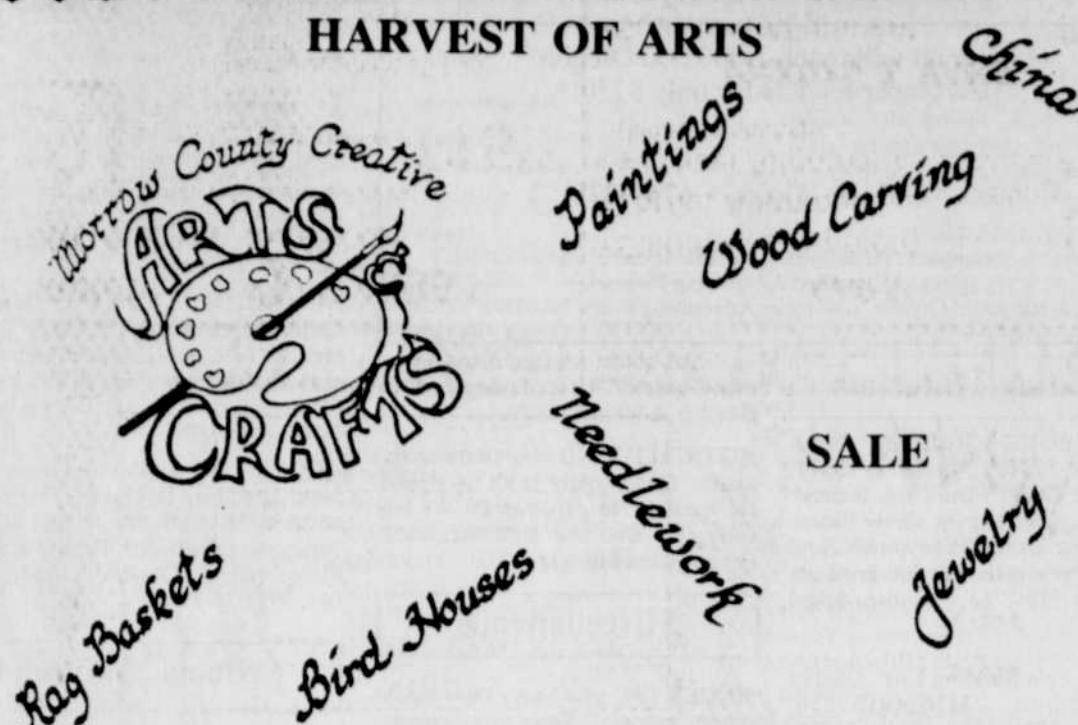
scripture reading of the Gospel of Mark 10:17-30.
