On Nov. 12, 1991, Heppner District Ranger, Roger W. Williams, made a decision to implement the P&M Thinning Project on the Heppner Ranger District. Thinning of the overstocked lodgepole pine stands would benefit forest health and produce healthy satisfactory cover for big game. Thinning would be completed by cutting trees with a chainsaw on a 12 x 12 or 8 x 8 spacing.
