Cost sharing emphasis on soil and water conservation

The Morrow County ASCS office cost shared with a total of 33 producers in Morrow County on Conservation practices in the amount of \$132,573 in 1991. "The emphasis is still on soil conservation, but with the majority of the CRP grass seedings complete and much of the conservation compliance work under way many cost share dollars are going toward water conservation," said Skip Matthews, ASCS

director. Pipelines and land leveling for flood irrigation were cost shared in the amount of \$38,884 last year. CRP, Long Term Agreement and regular grass seedings made up the bulk of the cost shares with \$76,307 going for those practices. Spring developments, reduced tillage and streambank stabilization utilized \$16,798 of the cost share funds last year also. The following chart summarizes the years activity.

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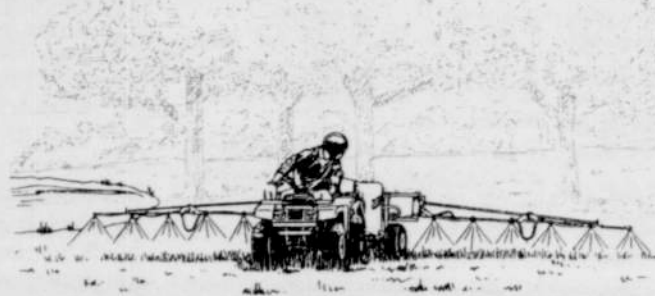
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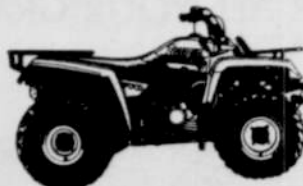
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
