Boardman and Heppner can't maintain library services at current levels. This measure creates a library district including the two Boardman and four Heppner precincts and governed by an elected board, two from Boardman, two from Heppner and one elected at large.

The proposed tax base keeps existing libraries open, allows expanded hours, and expands services to outside the cities.

Approval of this measure would reduce the property tax collections of other nonschool district units of local government available under the provisions of section 11b, Article XI, Oregon Constitution and implementing legislation.
