Museum to show video May 22

"Hearts and Hands: A Social History of Nineteenth Century Women and Quilts," a video and discussion program, will be presented on Friday, May 22 at 7 p.m. at the Morrow County Museum. The public is invited and admission is free.

The program is sponsored by the Morrow County Museum and is made possible by the Oregon Council for the Humanities, an affiliate of the National Endowment for the Humanities.

"Hearts and Hands" presents a vital part of American history only now beginning to be told—the role played by women and their textiles in the 19th century's great movements and events. The video explores the lives and accomplishments of ordinary, often anonymous women who used the needle to speak to each other and to posterity, as well as chronic-

ing the lives of extraordinary individuals such as Harriet Tubman and Oregon's own Abigail Scott Duniway.

Presenting the video and leading audience discussion will be Elizabeth Hoffman, a specialist in the cultural history of textiles. Dr. Hoffman received her Ph.D. from the University of Oregon in 1991.
