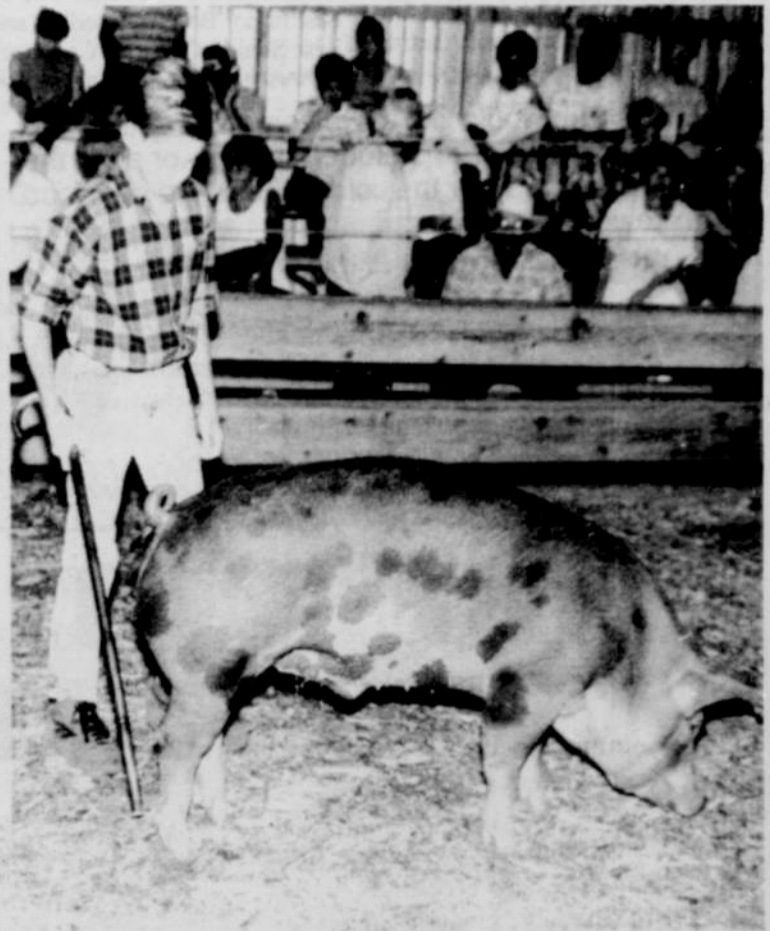
The 4-H youth have worked hard on their animals to prepare them for fair. Members and leaders hope that everyone can receive a good price for their animals.
