There will be two age groups: three and under and four and five year olds. Contestants do not need to live in Morrow County and will be admitted free when accompanied by a paid adult.

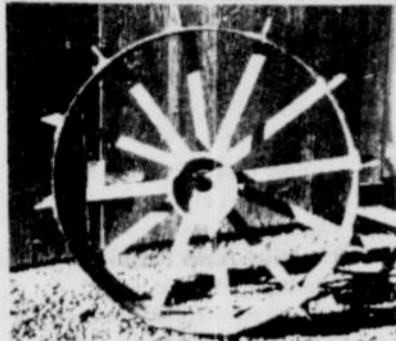
