

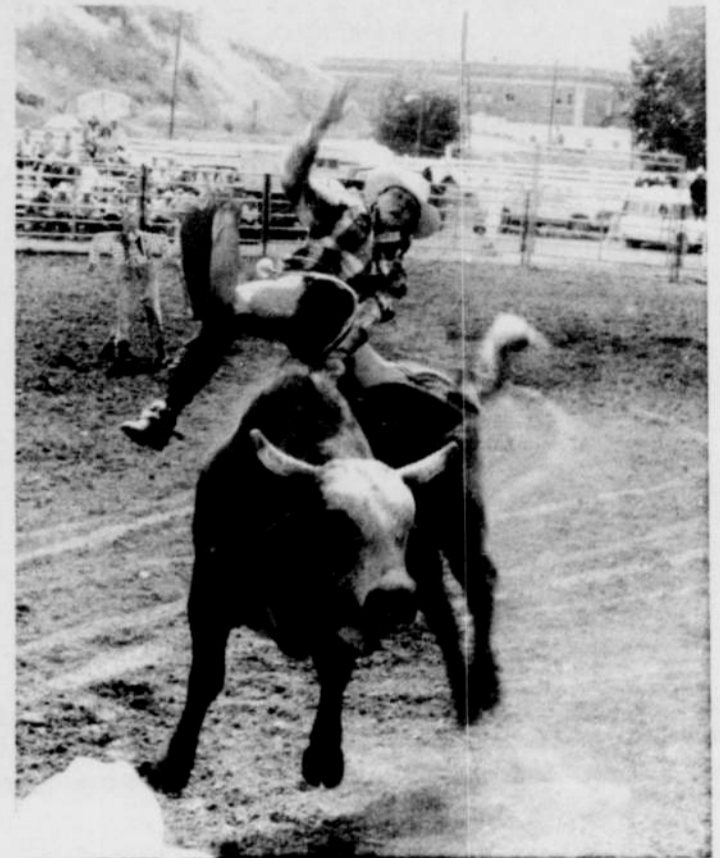

Local entries for the Oregon Trail Pro Rodeo, August 22 and 23, will be taken by rodeo secretary Marlene Currin on August 13. Contestants should call 676-9711 or 676-9141 or stop by the office of Kuhn & Spicer. Each local entry must sign a release form. All local entries submitted must be accompanied by a social security number for each entry. Local entries must

close and be called in before 7 p.m. Aug. 13 to PRCA headquarters.

In addition to entry fees, contestants owe for insurance, stock charges, PROCOM fees and electric eye charges.

Local entrants may call PROCOM 1-800-234-7722 after 7 a.m. Aug. 17 to find out when they are performing.
