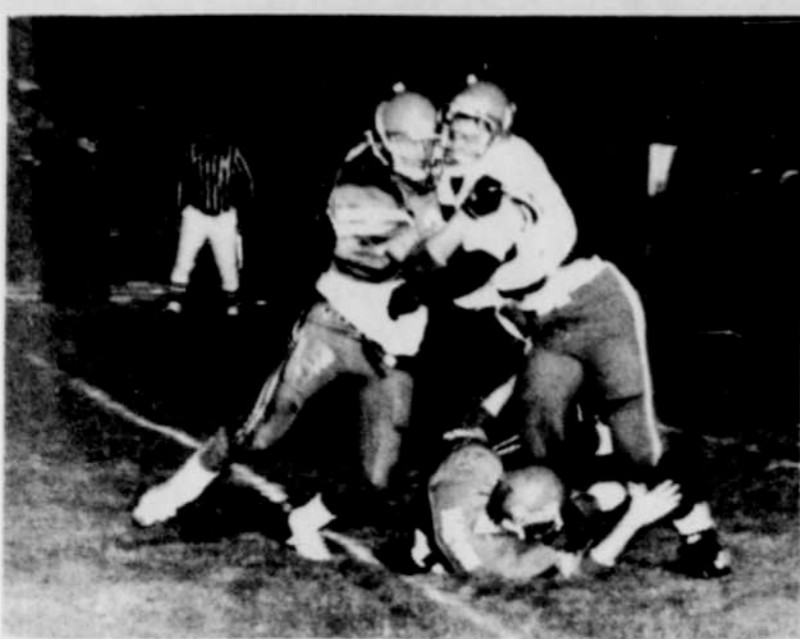


Mustangs take on Wahtonka 40-0



The Heppner Mustangs are still galloping along undefeated after a 40-0 white-washing of the visiting Wahtonka Eagles Friday night, Oct. 23.

The homecoming game was a special night as the Heppner Booster Club unveiled the new lights and scoreboard at the Morrow County Fairgrounds field.

The game was close through the first 1 1/2 quarters with the Mustangs leading only 6-0. Heppner exploded for three touchdowns in the last 4:04 of the second quarter and two more in the first six minutes of the third quarter to put the game out of reach.

Senior running back Kevin Payne scored the first of his two touchdowns with a seven yard run. Payne gained 61 yards on the evening on 10 carries. Kicker Len Brittner was wide right on the pat for a 6-0 lead.

After an exchange of punts, Wahtonka put together a 12-play, 79 yard drive, probably the best drive of the year against the first team defense, only to be stopped at the one yard line on the fourth down.

The Mustangs drove the length of the field but were stopped inside the Eagle eight yard line on downs. After forcing Wahtonka to punt, sophomore Chris Dickenson scored on an acrobatic twisting 12 yard run with 4:04 remaining in the half. Brittner added the pat for a 13-0 lead.

Defensive end Tony Burt pounced on a fumble at the Eagle 45 yard line on the next series of downs. After a 20 yard Rick Koffler to Scott Coe screen pass, Koffler hit Coe with a six yard slant pass for a touchdown. With 53 seconds remaining Brittner added the pat for a 20-0 lead.

Wahtonka wouldn't let the clock run out and Payne intercepted a pass. He returned it to the Eagle 36 yard line with only 18 ticks left on the clock. Quarterback Koffler hit Len Brittner with a perfect 36 yard touchdown pass on the Mustangs' first play from scrimmage. The pat snap was muffed as the Mustangs led 26-0 at the break.

Both Dickenson and Payne scored on two yard runs in the third quarter, to make the score 40-0.

The Mustang defense recorded their third shut out in a row.

Wahtonka could only muster 176 yards rushing and passing while the Mustangs had 430 yards of offense.

Two way starter Dwayne Dunaway missed the game with a sprained ankle and is questionable for this week against Weston-McEwen.
