

### Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's office reports dispatching the following business during the past week:

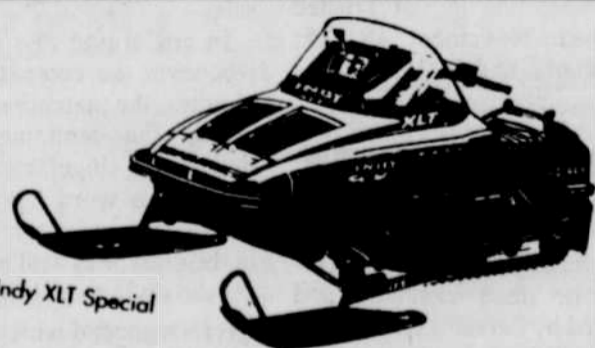
