Donald Wayne 'Butch' Carey

A memorial service will be held for Donald Wayne 'Butch' Carey, former Heppner resident, on May 1 at the McNary Dam Park. The service will begin at 2 p.m. Mr. Carey of Battle Mountain, Nev., died April 20 at the age of 44.

Mr. Carey was born Aug. 30, 1948, in Burns. He lived in Springfield from 1954 to 1960 and attended Mount Vernon Elementary School in Springfield. He graduated from Wheeler County High School in Fossil in 1966. He served four years in the U.S. Navy as a hospital corpsman and served three tours of duty in Viet Nam between 1966 and 1971. He was wounded and decorated for bravery and valor.

A resident of Eastern Oregon and Eugene, Carey worked at many trades including mill work, logging, forestry, reforestation, landscaping, foundry and mining. He had been employed by Battle Mountain Gold Co. for six years at the time of his death. He had been commended for his work on a number of public service projects in the community. His hobbies included hunting and fishing and he had recently taken up photography to capture his love for nature. He married Paula Evans in 1974 in Condon. He is survived by his wife at

the home; a daughter Teleska Nicole of Bradenton, Fla.; his father, William of Eugene; step-father, Raymond Hampton of Stanfield; five sisters Judy Davis, Heppner, Rhoda Wilcox, Eugene, Billie Duke, Veneta, Jackie Williams, Burns and Mary Lou Lasore, Pendleton; five brothers Troy and Douglas, Portland; Tony, White City, Gordon 'Bud' Fulton, Burns, Rick Fulton, Mount Vernon and Bill Fulton, Seattle, WA. He was preceded in death by his mother Judy Hampton of Heppner and his stepmother, Wyoma Carey, Eugene.
