"Looking the Part," on the Oregon Trail was presented by Ricia, on Saturday, May 1 at the Heppner multipurpose room. The workshop, sponsored by the Morrow County Extension Service was well attended with people coming from as far away as Joseph. The workshop provided

## FmHA nominations due in office May 19

The Farmers Home Administration (FmHA) is accepting nominations for county committee elections for Morrow, Umatilla, and Gilliam County area committee. This notice is issued to inform eligible voters of the right to nominate candidates by petition. Copies of the petition and instructions on its completion may be obtained from your local FmHA office.

Persons nominated should have

an interest in a farm as an owner, tenant, or sharecropper within the county or area in which activities of the county or area committee are carried out. They must be citizens of the United States or aliens lawfully admitted to the United States for permanent residence, and be qualified for committee work. Spouses of those persons who meet the eligibility criteria are also eligible for nomination for election to the

county committee. Nominations must be received in the Pendleton office no later than Wednesday, May 19. FmHA committee elections are open to all eligible voters without regard to race, color, religion, national origin, age, political affiliation, marital status, sex, or handicap.

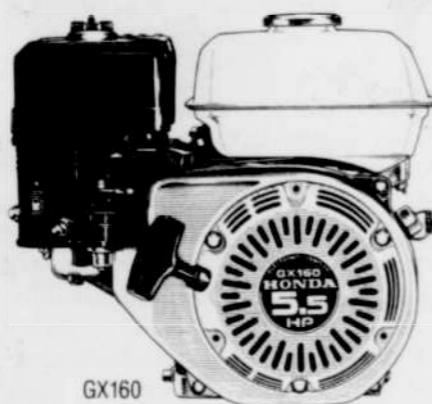
