

**Lori Moeller sets new record at track meet**

The Heppner Middle School track team traveled to Umatilla on May 6. Special highlight for the day was a new school record set by Lori Moeller in the discus at 72'9". The old record was held by T. Lindsey in 1985 at 69'1". Melissa Cutsforth, a seventh grader also broke it earlier at the meet 72' 1/2", only to have Moeller break it again.

Brent Gunderson took third in the discuss, second in the 100m and medley relay and first in the 200m. David Michael jumped 5'2" while Damien Wilhelm took second in the long jump with 16'.

Wilhelm also placed second in the softball throw and fourth in the 100 and 200m.

Mindy Qualls took a second in the 200 and 800m, and first in the medley relay. Nicole VanEtta threw the softball for a fourth place finish and was part of the first place medley relay and took third in the 800m.

Michael was fourth in the high jump, second in the 400m and third in the 200m. Cam Sweeney took a fifth in the high jump and 1200m. Stacy Lauritsen placed first in the 1200m. David Gray placed fourth in the shot with a throw of 33'4", fifth in the softball throw and third in the 4x100 relay.

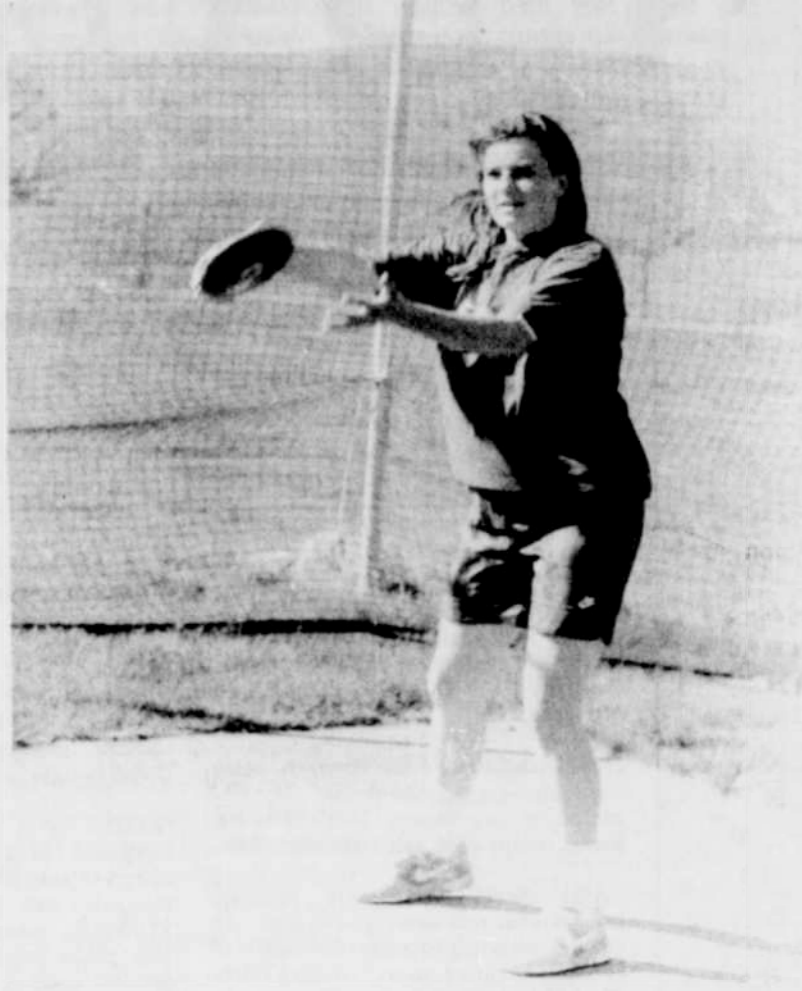
Traci Dickenson took a first in the 100m hurdles, high jump and medley relay.
