**Where's the beef, pork, lamb chops at the county fair?**

Where is the beef? The answer to that question is Morrow County Fair. Last year there were 22 market steers at the fair. This year at spring weigh-in there were 42. Not all will come to fair, but there will probably be around 35 at fair. There will also be more breeding projects than there have been for a long time. There has also been an inquiry about open class beef. So while you are at the

fair, check out the beef barn. The hog barn will also be crowded. There were 103 hogs weighed-in at the spring weigh-in. That number, like the steers, is way up. "We will probably be running around trying to make more pens to accommodate them," said a 4-H spokesperson. "It is hard to believe just a few years ago there were only 19 hogs at fair."

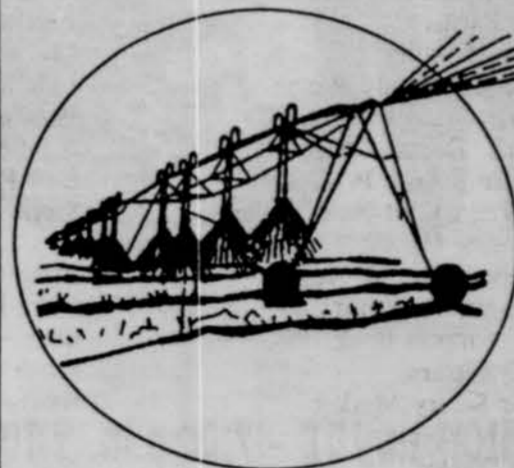

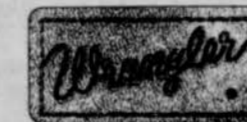
