Morrow County Rodeo changes days



The Morrow County Amateur Rodeo, previously held on Friday night of fair and rodeo week, will be held on Sunday, August 21 at 1 p.m. This event has been rescheduled so that the first performance of the Oregon Trail Pro Rodeo will take place on Friday, August 19 at 7 p.m.

Sunday's amateur rodeo will also offer new entertainment. The first event will be goat tying with two age divisions. The first go-round for boys and girls ages 9-13 is sponsored by the Wranglers Riding Club. Girls ages 14-18 will compete in the 2nd go-round of goat tying. This event is sponsored by Turner Ranches.

The second event also new this year, is steer dobbing for boys and girls ages 10-17. Sponsor for this event is Dick Temple, DVM.

The Morrow County Rodeo is open to all Morrow County residents who have lived in the county for six months or are alumni of Morrow County schools.

at the gate.

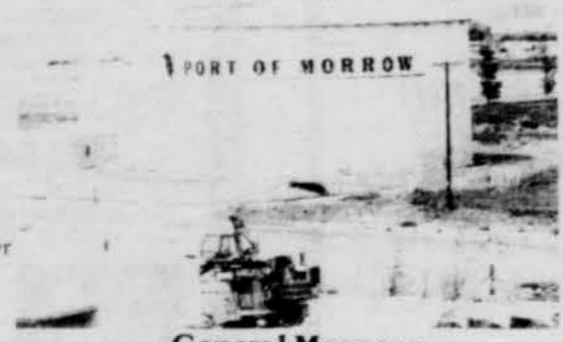

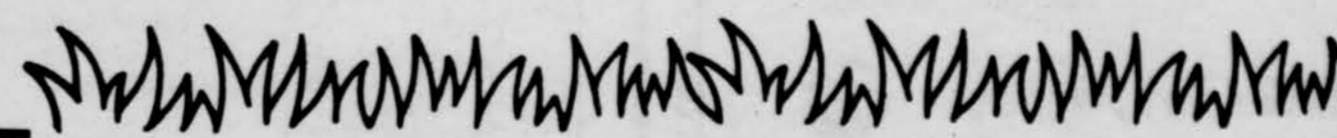
