Eugene W. Wigglesworth filed an application with the Water Resources Department for a change in point of diversion of water from Butter Creek as provided by ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

Certificate 64173, in the name of Edward Burl Wattenberger, Jr., includes a right limited to 2.53 cubic foot per second from Butter Creek, with priority dates of 1872, 1890 and 1896 for irrigation of 127.5 acres.

The point of diversion, among others, for this right is in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4, Section 3, T 1 N, R 27 E, WM; 370' South and 300' East from the N 1/4 corner, Section 3.

The applicant proposes to change the point of diversion to the NW 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 3, T 1 N, R 27 E, WM; 3465' South and 845' East from the N corner, Section 3.
