\$485,000 be established to support the Morrow County Health District effective

this measure is to establish a tax base to support a county-wide health district which
 direct health care services to the people of Morrow County. The tax levy necessary
 is subject to the other governmental limits of Section 11b, Article XI of the Oregon
 Constitution. Revenues to be raised will be used for providing medical care, dental care and emergency medical
 services within Morrow County. The estimated tax impact within the county-wide district is \$.63
 per \$1,000 of assessed value based on current valuations; this is an estimate only based on the best information
 available at the time of the estimate.

MEASURE NO. 25-12
 FORMATION OF A MORROW COUNTY MEDICAL DISTRICT,
 WITH TAX BASE

QUESTION: Shall a health district with a tax base of \$600,000.00 be formed to serve Morrow County, excepting
 the Boardman Community?

SUMMARY: This measure proposes to form a health district to be responsible for providing medical services
 to the people residing within the district. The district would include all of Morrow County except the area lying
 north of the section lines forming the north boundary of the Bombing Range (extended west to the Morrow/Gilliam
 County boundary) and west of an imaginary line extending from Bombing Range Road to the Columbia River.
 The district, if approved, would be formed with a tax base of \$600,000.00; the tax levy necessary to raise this
 amount of revenue is subject to the limits of Section 11b, Article XI of the Oregon Constitution. Revenues to
 be raised will be used for direct health care, such as physician services, medical equipment, and ambulance,
 and not for exclusively educational and support services. The estimated tax impact within the territory which
 comprises the district is \$.8876 per thousand dollars of value, based on current valuations; this is an estimate
 only based on the best information available from the County Assessor at the time of estimate.
