



Mushrooms preserved

The season for collecting edible mushrooms from the Blue Mountains will soon be here. For a large harvest that cannot be consumed quickly, freezing mushrooms is an easy process.

To freeze mushrooms: select edible mushrooms free from spots or decay. Wash and remove stem base. Cut large mushrooms into three or four pieces; small ones can be frozen whole.

Destroy ripening enzymes and prevent darkening by blanching three to five minutes in a solution of three teaspoons of lemon juice per quart of boiling water. Cool blanched mushrooms by cooling quickly in ice water.

A second method of preparation is to slice mushrooms 1/4 inch thick, saute in butter until almost done. Cool by setting saute pan in cold water.

Pack chilled mushrooms in plastic freezer bags and store at 0°F or lower. For best flavor, use within 12 months.
