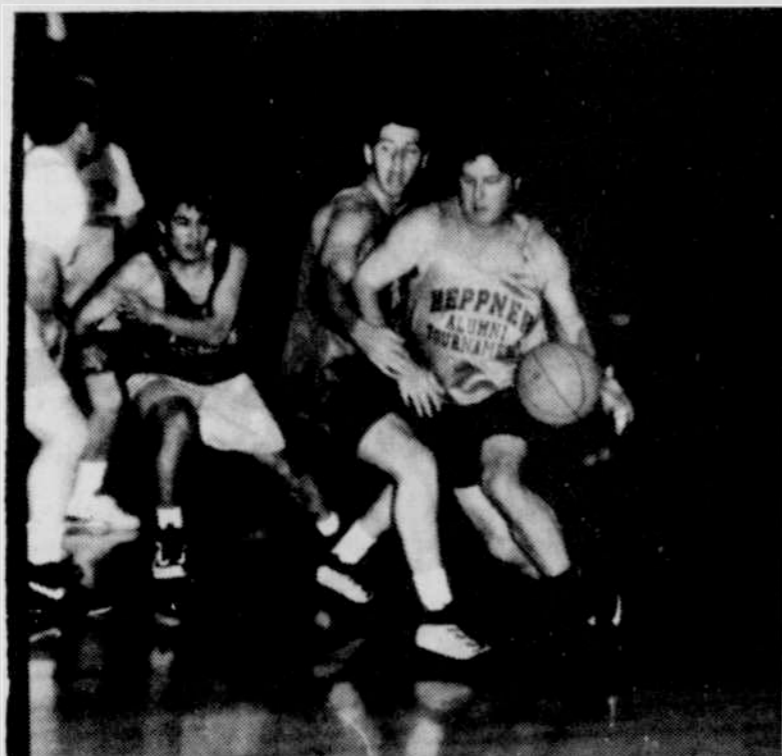
Proceeds from the annual tournament fund scholarships and promote athletics in Heppner.

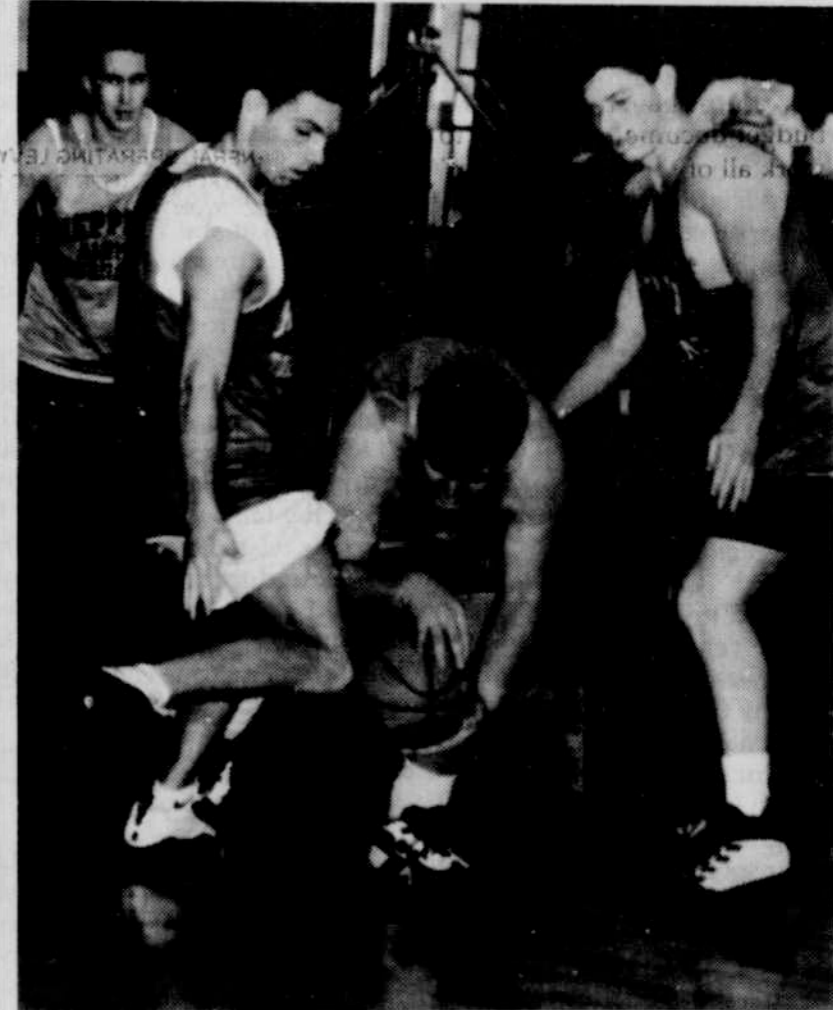
