Ione Little League signups will be held Thursday, March 7, at 7 p.m. at the Ione High School cafeteria.

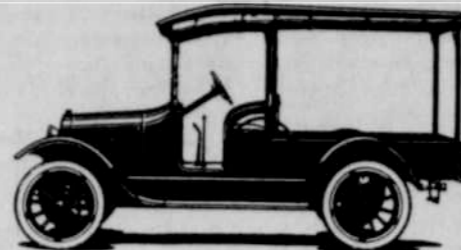

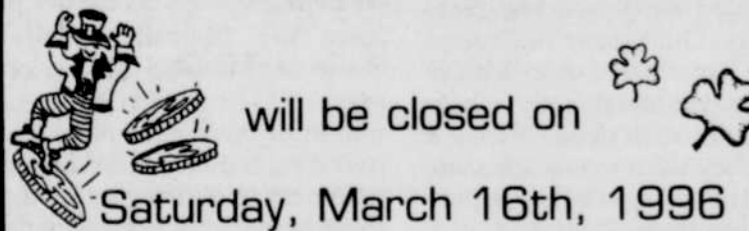
