## Theatre group to offer second reading

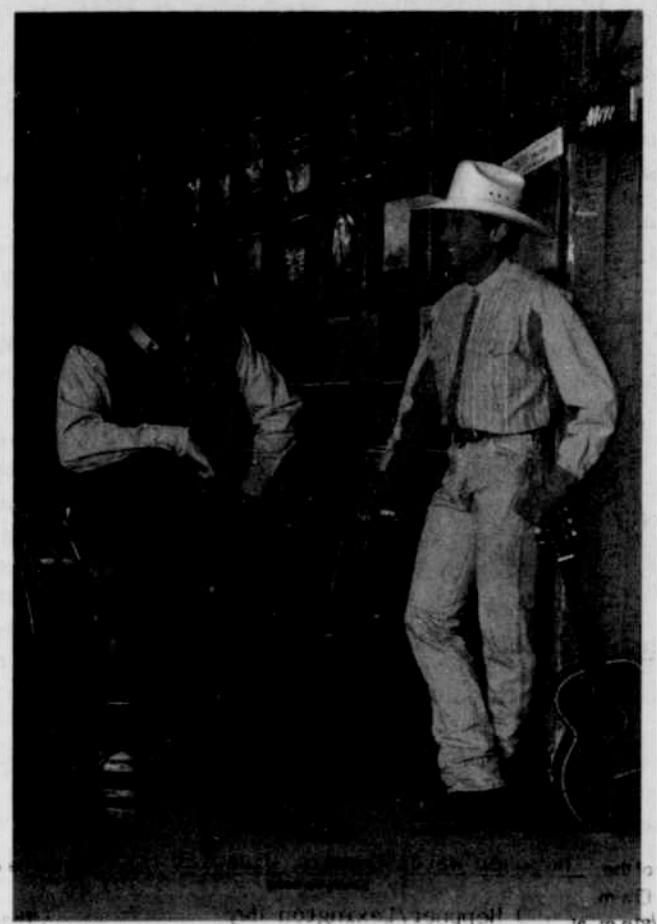
