Missionaries to speak at Nazarene Church

The Reverend and Mrs. James Rotz, missionaries to South Africa, will present a program at the Heppner Church of the Nazarene on Thursday, Oct. 31.

Reverend and Mrs. Rotz were appointed to South Africa as missionaries by the Church of the Nazarene in 1982. They are on furlough and holding services across the United States and Canada.

Reverend Rotz was born in Denver, CO., and graduated from Northwest Nazarene College in Nampa, ID., with a B.A. degree. He later received a master of divinity degree from Nazarene Theological Seminary in Kansas City, MO.

Carol Rotz was born in Sheldon, IA. She earned a B.A. degree at Northwest Nazarene College, an M.A. from Olivet Nazarene University in 1987, an M.A. from the University of

Port Elizabeth, South Africa in 1992, and a bachelor of theology degree at Africa Nazarene Theological College in South Africa. Before their appointment as missionaries, the Rotzes pastored in Colorado and Oklahoma.

In 1982, the Rotz family began their assignment as teachers at the Port Elizabeth campus of Africa Nazarene Theological College in South Africa. In January 1990, they moved to Johannesburg when the college moved there, merging the four Nazarene Bible colleges of South Africa. In November 1994, they transferred to Africa Nazarene University in Nairobi, Kenya.

The Rotzes, who have two children, Gary and David, will make their furlough home in Vancouver, WA.
