Sheriff's office received a request for an officer concerning noise at a residence at Oasis RV Park in Irrigon.

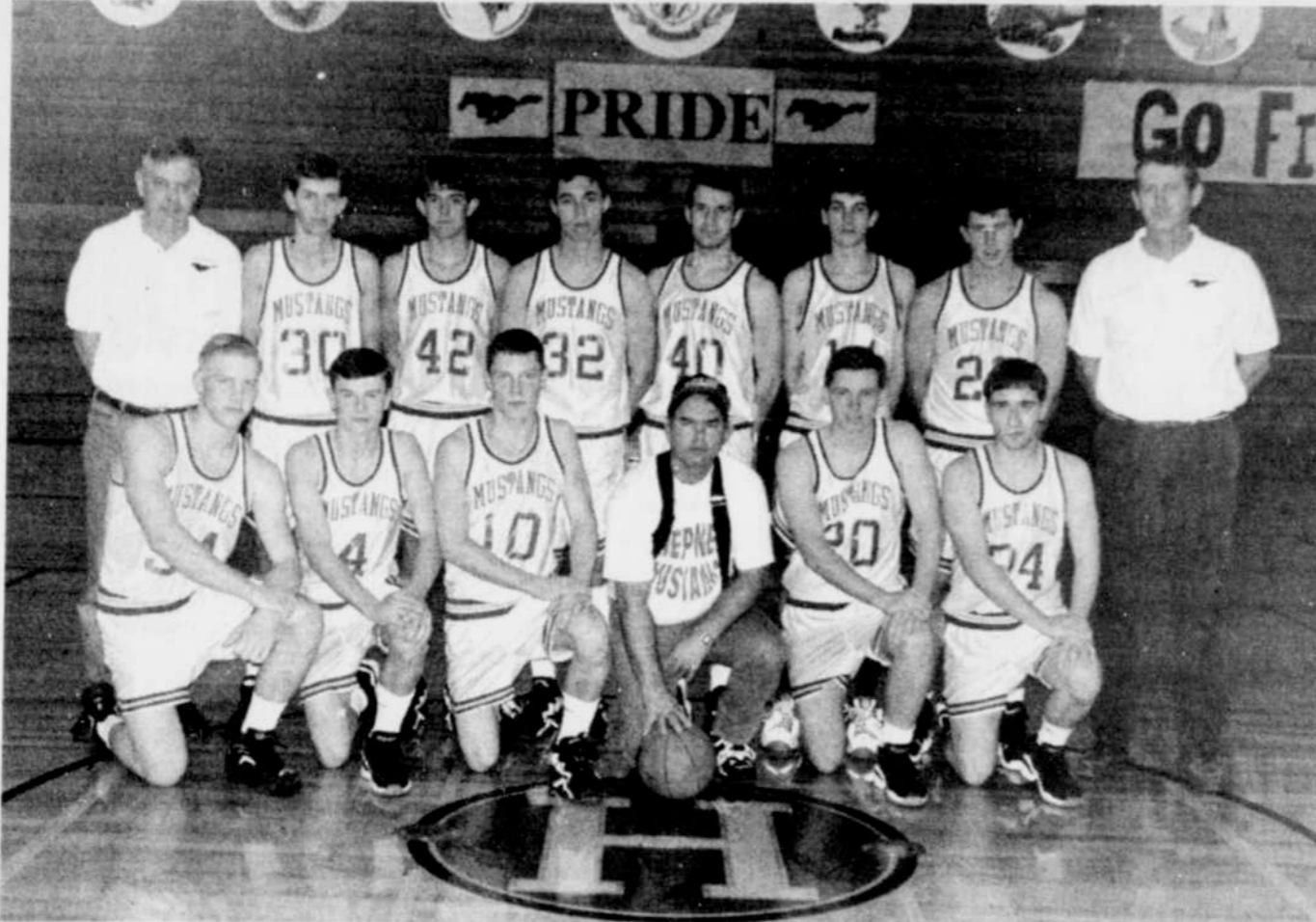
