"The history of 75 years of Heppner Rodeo was excellent," says an anonymous Gazette-Times reader, "but one thing wasn't mentioned."

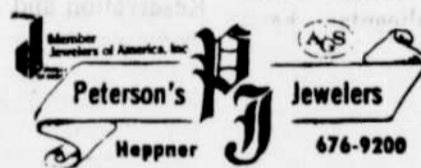

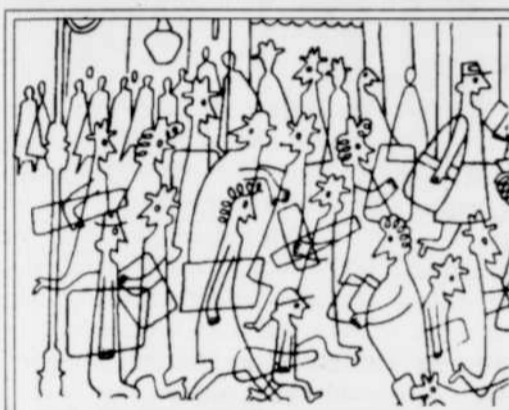
