

### Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's office reports handling or dispatching the following business during the past several weeks:

MCSO received a report of a gun stolen at a residence near Heppner.

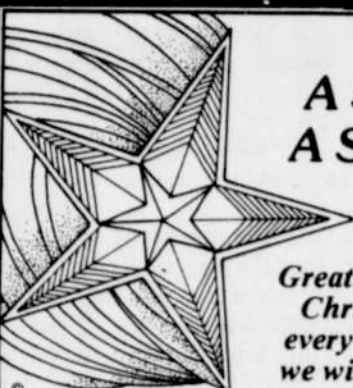
MCSO received information concerning a missing person who was located.
