## Plain Speaking #2 RUNAWAY REGULATION

Often, when Oregon citizens get whacked by some heavy-handed (or just plain stupid) government regulation, they're shocked to discover the rule wasn't implemented by their legislature, but cooked-up and adopted by bureaucrats who don't have to answer to the voters ... even though the rules have the full force of law on you and me!

Look, if we have to live with a law, it should take more than just a decision by government career types ... and their pals in back offices.

The proper way to create a law is to convince thirty-one members of the State House of Representatives, sixteen State Senators, and the Governor that your idea benefits the state. But over time, legislators have recklessly handed over law-making power to bureaucracies, without building in any practical system of checks or review.

Getting control of runaway administrative rules is long overdue. That's why I'm supporting and circulating a petition for a safety valve we call the "Regulation Review" measure.

Here's how it would work: when citizens find an agency rule is obstructionist, petty, or dumb, and, if they can collect 25,000 voters' signatures, that rule has to be reviewed by the legislature. If the rule doesn't pass muster, it's history. That's it ... straightforward, simple and democratic.
