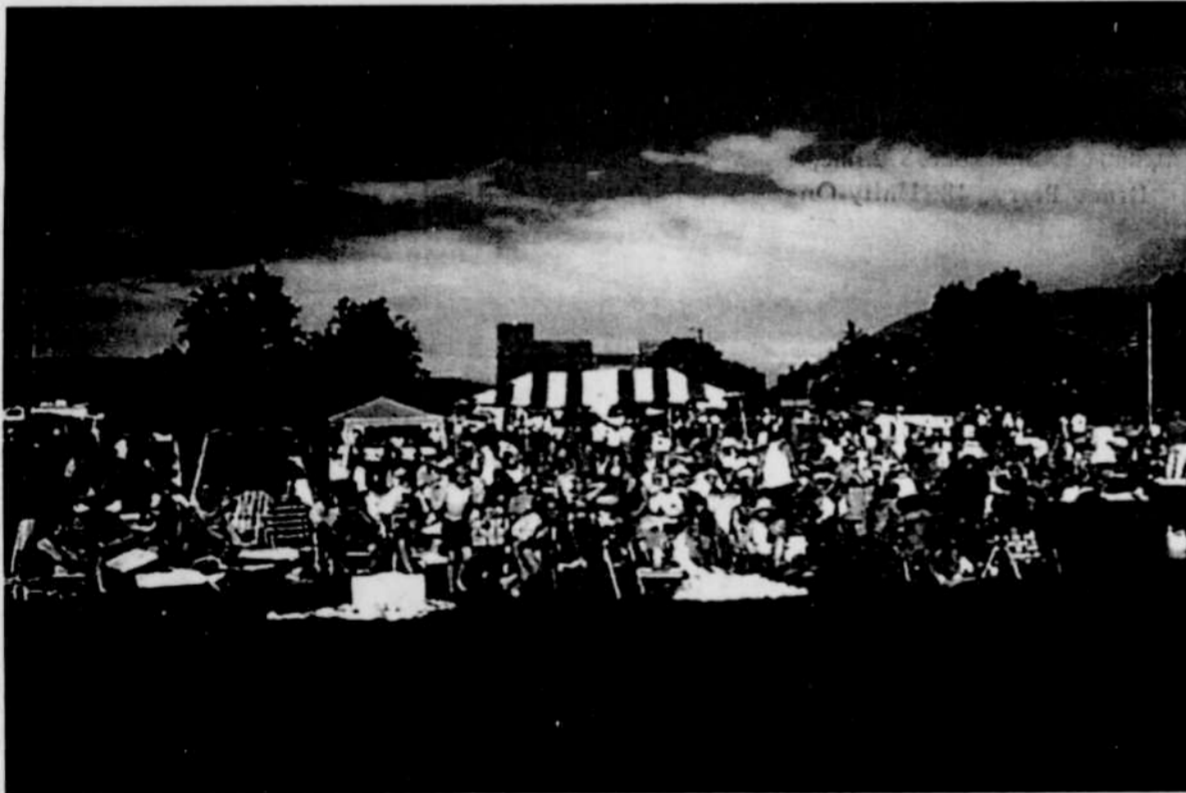
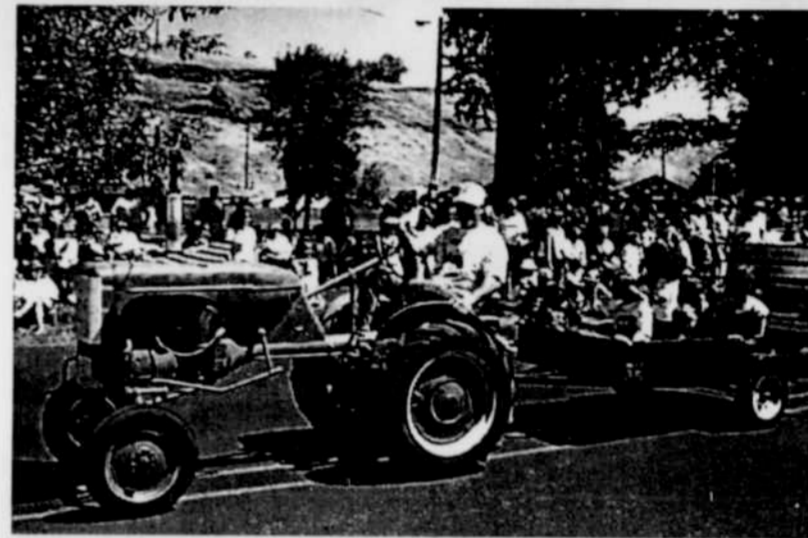
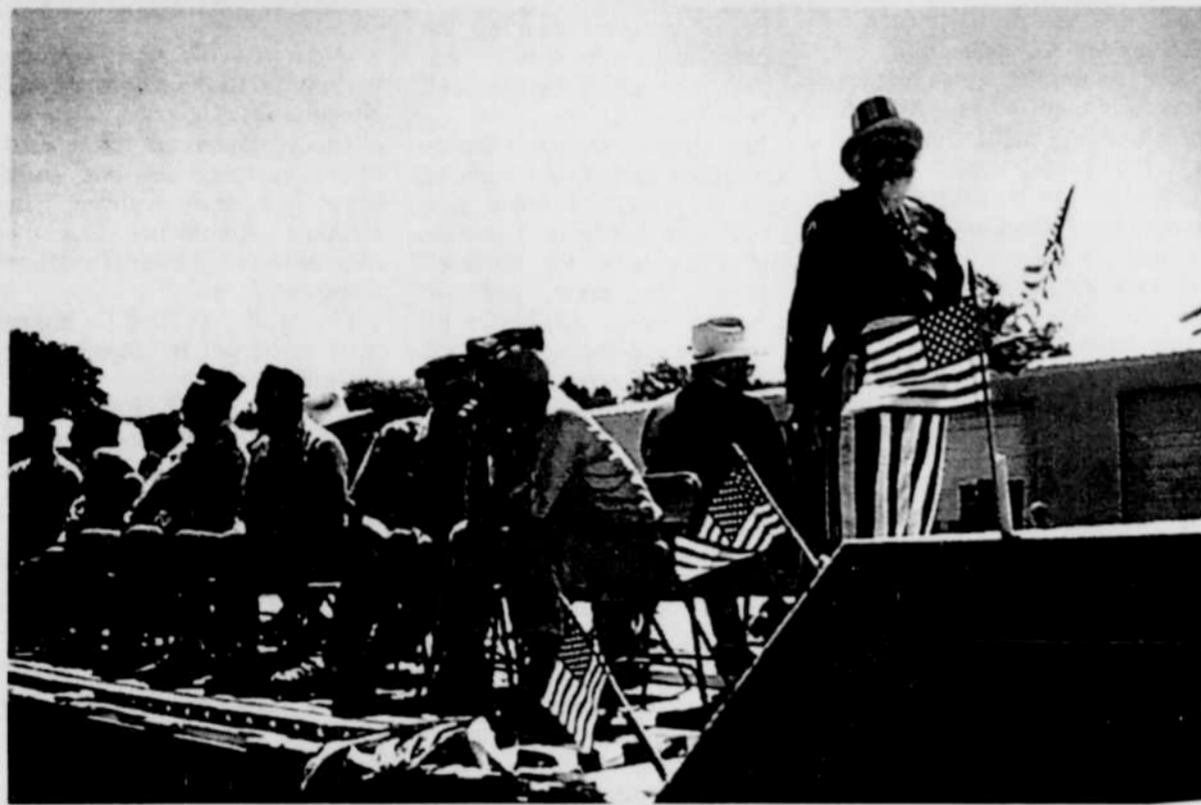

Child abuse was discussed as a priority target for future planning and spending during the June meeting of the Morrow County Commission on Children and Families (MCCCCF). The commission has designated approximately \$7,000 for projects that will specifically address the root causes of child abuse and neglect.
