Seminar courses include a four-hour core course, "Oregon Laws and Business Practices"; elective courses "Accounting and Record Keeping for Contractors," "Basic Contract Law for Contractors," "Oregon Lien Law for Contractors," and "Jobsite Safety, OSHA and Workers' Compensation."

No test is required since participants will complete the course with an instructor present. A certificate will be given to participants who complete the course. The seminar is taught by Acorn Legal Resources, Inc., an accredited provider by the Oregon Contractors Board.
