Mustangs face Regis in first round

The Heppner Mustang football team will play the Regis Rams on Saturday, Nov. 14, at 1 p.m. in the first round of the state 2A playoffs. The game is scheduled to be played at Cascade High School in Turner, which is located between Salem and Stayton.

Ticket prices for this contest and all OSAA football play-off games are \$6 for adults and \$4 for students.

Heppner finished second to Culver in the Columbia Basin Conference and Regis won the Tri-River Conference.

Both schools faced a common opponent this year in Scio. Heppner lost a heartbreaker in their first game of the season 24-

12 while Regis won 15-13.

Going into their final game Regis is seven and one overall, losing to Dayton, 37-21, playing without starting quarterback Paul Lulay. The 6'1", 175 pound junior completed 46 of 72 passes for 780 yards. Lulay had 15 touchdown passes and only three interceptions. Freshman Travis Lulay completed 26 of 50 passes for 395 yards and five touchdowns and three interceptions.

Adam Lulay, 5'10", 190 pound senior, led the Rams in rushing 656 yards on 102 carries and 12 touchdowns. Dustin Lulay, 6' 190 pound senior, rushed 41 times for 380 yards and five touchdowns. He also had 21

receptions for 413 yards and four touchdowns.

The leading receiver Nate Brentano, 5' 10" 155 pound senior, had 30 receptions for 538 yards and 11 touchdowns.

The defensive leaders are Bryon Birkholz, 5'10" 170 pound senior linebacker, Dustin Lulay at linebacker and Heath Etzel, 6' 190 pound senior lineman.

The rams have rushed for 1380 yards for the season and have passed for 1175 yards. Their opponents have rushed for 1118 yards and gained only 115 yards passing.

Regis has outscored their opponents 328 to 79 for the year.
