

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

MCSO received a request for a deputy from an Irrigon man who reported dogs in his garden.

MCSO received a report from a man who said two men approached him asking about work and one appeared intoxicated.
