

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

MCSO, Boardman Police Dept. received a report of a found Chihuahua. They gave it to a person to keep until the owner could be found. The owner wanted to give it away and the caretaker wanted it, so the dog had a new home for Christmas.
