

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

January 18: MCSO received a report that cattle spotted the previous night were still in the wheat fields doing damage.

MCSO received a request for a deputy at Columbia Middle School in Irrigon to cite someone for theft.

MCSO deputy cited a 13 year old for Theft III.

MCSO deputy, while transporting a juvenile, was flagged down by a citizen spotting a possible DUII at the Irrigon Post Office. There was no one in position to respond and Oregon State Police were advised.

MCSO received a request for a house watch at a residence.
