

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

June 3: Boardman Ambulance, BPD received report of a 14-year old with rapid breathing and shaking with no known medical history. He was transported to Good Shepherd Hospital.

HPD cited a 14-year old for MIP tobacco.

BPD, MCSO received report of a domestic dispute in Boardman. It was a verbal dispute.
