Visitors are welcome to attend.



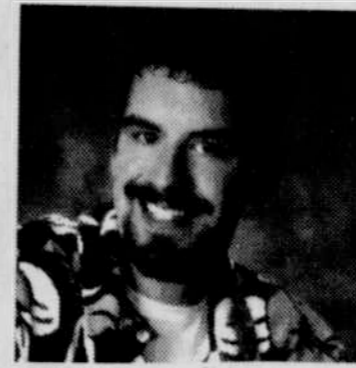

## Cargill awards scholarship

Cargill has awarded a \$1,000 scholarship to Justin Nelson, a 2000 graduate of Heppner High School.

Nelson, son of Charles and Lisa Nelson, Lexington, plans to study agricultural business management at Oregon State University next fall.

Each year, Cargill's Scholarship Program for Rural America

awards \$1,000 scholarships to 250 students from families who derive at least 50 percent of their income from farming.

Students are selected based on financial need, academic achievement and involvement in extra curricular activities. The program is administered by the National FFA Organization; however, students need not belong to FFA to receive a scholarship.

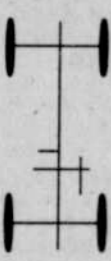

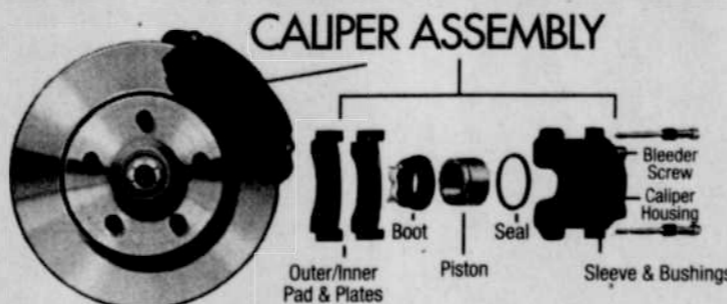

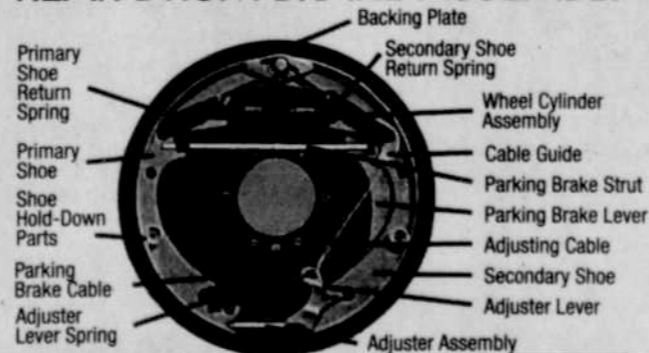
