

### Wheat Growers plan workshop

The Oregon Wheat Growers League, in conjunction with the Morrow County Wheat Growers, have scheduled Monday, August 21, as the date for a risk management workshop entitled, "The Three C's of Success - Crop Insurance; Computers; and Contracts."

The workshop is funded by a grant from the USDA Risk Management Agency. The workshop will be held at the Heppner Elks Club from 9 a.m.-2 p.m., with lunch included (sponsored in part by Rain and Hail, LLC).

Attendees will hear from representatives of the Risk Management Agency about major legislative changes in the crop insurance program to assist them in their decisions prior to the sales closing date of September 30.

They will also obtain some new insights on contract negotiations and skills for reviewing and determining the viability of contracts before they sign.

The third component of this workshop is the "hands on" computer lab to educate the attendees on how to make some of the common computer programs work more effectively in their farm operations.

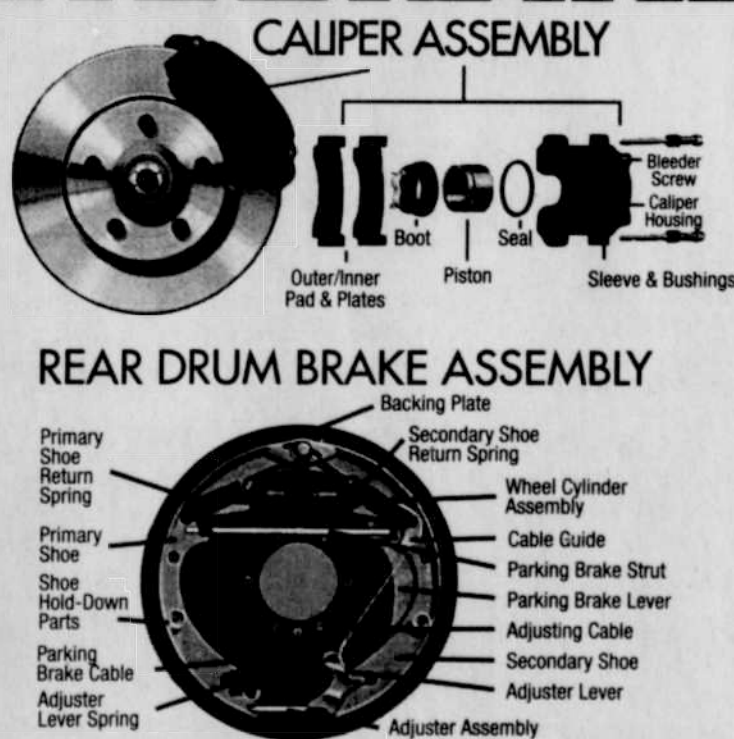
