

## Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

MCSO received report from a Boardman man that his wife gets violent and said she threw a phone at him and left, probably to go drink. He was concerned she would come home and get violent.

OSP received report of horses out on Mc Nabb and Smith in Ione.
