

R&W supports reading education



Alex Rystedt, the owner of the R & W Drive-In in Heppner, continues to support reading education at Heppner Elementary School with his R & W Reading Program.

For several years, the R & W Drive-In has been awarding HES students' reading with ice cream treats.

During this school year, children

from kindergarten through sixth grade have earned 242 ice cream certificates, or 123 single scoop ice cream cones, 72 small sundaes, 32 double scoop ice cream cones, 11 small milkshakes and four small R & W Delights donated by Rystedt.

In the reading program, individual classroom teachers decide what a student needs to accomplish in order

to be granted a certificate. The goals range from two to six hours of reading with appropriate reports, to the number of books read and the number of pages. As a result, kindergarten through third grade students read a total of 671 hours, the fourth grade read a total of 121 books and the fifth and sixth graders read 15,200 pages.
