

## Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

-MCSO received a report of items stolen out of the back of the caller's vehicle in Irrigon and he thought he knew who took them.

**March 25:** MCSO received a report of an audible alarm at Huwe's Washboard. It was an employee error.

-MCSO, Boardman Police Dept. received a report of a motor vehicle accident at the I-84 eastbound exit of the Port of Morrow. Several female juveniles were walking around. The vehicle involved was determined to have been stolen from Pomeroy, Washington, although at the time the owner did not know it was missing. The vehicle was impounded.
