

Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

MCSO, Boardman Police Dept. received a report of a dog running through the neighborhood and knocking over garbage cans in Boardman.

MCSO, Boardman Police and Fire depts. received a report of an oven fire in an apartment in Boardman. The fire was extinguished and there was no fire damage.

April 23: MCSO, Oregon State Police received a report of an erratic driver on Highway 730 from Umatilla to Irrigon. No one was in position to respond.
