Sheriff's Report

The Morrow County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) reports handling the following business:

-MCSO, Boardman Fire Dept. received a report of a grass fire on the east side of Oregon Hay along the railroad tracks. It was a controlled burn.

-MCSO received a report of a small grass fire along I-84 eastbound. It was out.

-MCSO, USFS received a report of an unattended controlled burn past Cutsforth Park to the west.

-MCSO received a report of Criminal Mischief III. A male subject had tried to start a fire in the bathrooms at the Irrigon Marina. The fire was out but the subject was still at the location.

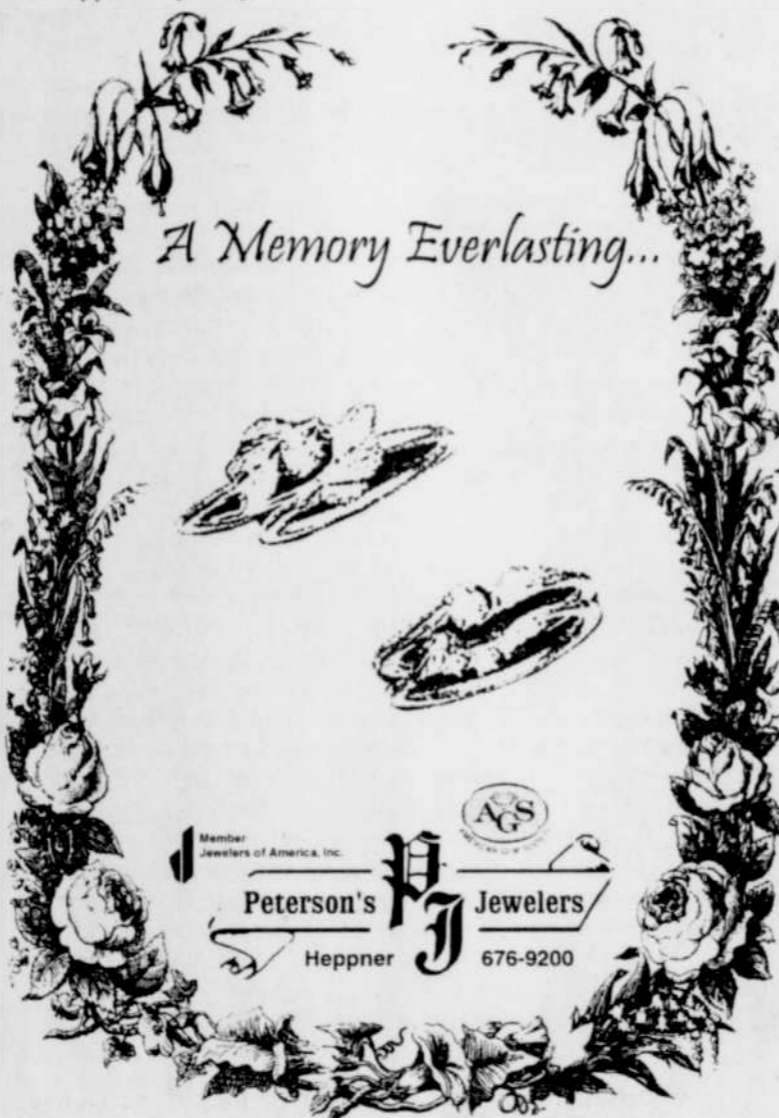
